How to make paper maché

What do you need;

- A stack of old newspapers.
- A bucket of hot water.
- Wallpaper glue
- Optional white wood glue (Elmer's glue)

How to make;

- Take a couple of old newspapers. The amount depends on how much paper maché you want to make.
- Tear them into small pieces and add hot water. Let this concoction soak for a few days until you get a homogeneous mass of paper fibres.
- Drain the mass well by squeezing the water out.
 Then add wallpaper glue and some Elmers glue (this is optional) to make a clay like substance.
 Store in a cool place.
